

## Setting up Sensory or Messy Play sessions Resources Checklist:

Essential Items Required	✓
Floor covering or wipeable mat	
Tuff Tray (on floor, table or stand) or smaller individual tray (Choice multiple colours available) Available Online from: Ikea, Amazon or TES.com	
Fine-motor lifting Tools & Sand Play - spoons, funnels, buckets, scoops, hand scissor skills scoops, empty water spray bottles, paint rollers, spades, moulds, tongs/tweezers, magnet wands & paper clips to make magnetic thematic targeting resources.	
Mark Making & Creative Development Tools - paint brushes (various sizes), paint rollers, chalks, crayons, pens, twistable colouring pencils, cotton buds, stampers, paper stamp cutters, tin foil, clingfilm, mirrors, coloured paper/card, non-standard mark making tools. (i.e. Everyday objects that can be used as brushes or stamps)	
Malleable & play dough Tools - rolling pins, selection of cutters, plastic knives, clay tools	
Water play Tools - clear buckets, funnels, floating toys, dolls, plastic thematic toys, scoops, boats, ducks, sponges, bubbles, food colouring, pipettes.	
Sensory Play essential Foods: - cereals, flour, cream, corn flour, food colouring, shaving foam (once child no-longer mouths items),	
Sensory Impairments Tools: - Light panel, gel activities, transparent toys, texture stepping stones or carpets samples, coloured scarves, parachute, bag of fidgets, gym ball.
